Both riders must be astraddle the horse in Cowboy Rescue when crossing the finish line. Judge and/or show committee's decisions are final. Reining pattern, judges choice, posted at entry booth by 10 AM. Exhibitors in the Western Pleasure classes must be neatly dressed in western style, consisting of western boots, western hat, long pants and long sleeved shirts. Optional attire may include chaps, gloves, spurs, vests & coats. Safety helmets will not be penalized. Adult assistance is not only allowed but encouraged for the youngsters, as we wish to keep them all safe while having fun!
