Easter Seals also offers:

- ♦ A place to try new activities and learn new skills like horseback riding, boating and camping.
- ♦ A place that will loan a wheelchair or other durable medical equipment to a family who cannot afford to buy one.
- ♦ A place that will help farmers who have a disability stay on the farm when they thought there was no hope.
- ♦ A place that provides employment training for people with a disability in the Des Moines area.
- ♦ A place that provides respite services to families and caregivers.
- ♦ A place that provides training for independent living, self-reliance and confidence in one's own abilities.

2011 PONY EXPRESS RIDES AGAIN!



2011– 44th Annual Pony Express Ride into Camp Sunnyside

On April 23rd, 2011 the Pony Express Riders of Iowa rode into Camp Sunnyside for the 44th consecutive year with the tradition of delivering the funds raised throughout the year, and *deliver*, they did..... Bringing in just over \$207,000, but with a fiscal year end totaling **\$232,563**, bringing it to a grand total of over **\$8.7 million** raised to benefit Easter Seals Camp Sunnyside and the disabled Iowans they serve.

Camp Sunnyside celebrated their 50th Birthday this year and we can be proud to say that we've strongly supported them for 44 of those 50 years!

Even with budget cuts & the continuing competition for donations, the dedicated Pony Express members & their helpers are finding ways to overcome obstacles & get our job done. It's great to see some counties "thinking outside the box" and trying some new fundraising ideas. This past year was our 2nd Annual Pony Express Weekend at River Valley in Farmington, and we surpassed last year's income by \$2,000, raising \$6024, & it was our first partnership with DD Rodeo & that also was a huge success, and our expectations are set High for both of these events next year.

We've also had some exceptional accomplishments this year that can't be measured by \$\$ amounts, including the Pony Express Riders winning the **Governor's Award**, & at the first ever Royalty Contest at the Iowa Horse Fair, Donae Hedlund, representing the Marshall County Pony Express, won the Senior Cowgirl Queen Contest, and at the Iowa State Fair Cowgirl Queen Contest, Rilee Proffitt, representing the Lucas County Pony Express won the Junior title. What positive exposure & signs of growth for the organization as more & more of these young people become involved & show their support.

What a wonderful feeling to know as a 44 year strong group, we CAN & DO make a difference in so many lives, let's keep growing & going strong for years to come!
