Highlights from Board of Directors Meeting, held November 13th

- By Laws Change:** the Board approved a By Laws change, this change consists of simply changing our fiscal year, the fiscal year will end on May 31st each year, rather than August 31st. This change will eventually make our book keeping simpler, since our fiscal year will end just shortly after Ride Day each year, and this change will also alleviate the problem of trying to project what our annual total will be, with expected funds coming in between ride day & August 31st.
- Motel:** the Board reviewed a proposal for another motel, and has instructed Carole to obtain a bit more information & report back at the January meeting for a Board vote. If anyone has another motel they’d like considered, please get the info to Carole as soon as possible, so she can gather the info and present to the Board for the vote.

The Board reviewed all the information, and voted to accept their offer which included, keeping him free of charge until Ride Day or shortly before. Tickets of course, will not be available for sale until after Ride Day’s drawing of the Ranger.
- Rodeo:** After the Board reviewed facts & figures presented by the Rodeo Committee, the motion was made & vote passed to partner with Double D Rodeo again this next year. The rodeo in August of 2011 was a success & profitable, the only problem being having done the rodeo on such short notice and the lack of help. This is a “statewide event” being held in Toledo, so we’d like to encourage everyone to help us do bigger & better things at this year’s Rodeo on August 3rd & 4th.
